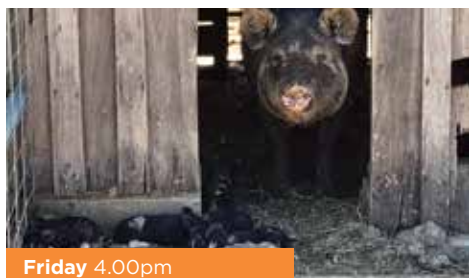

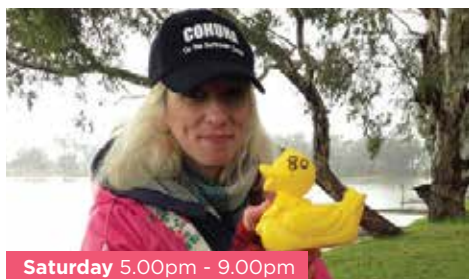

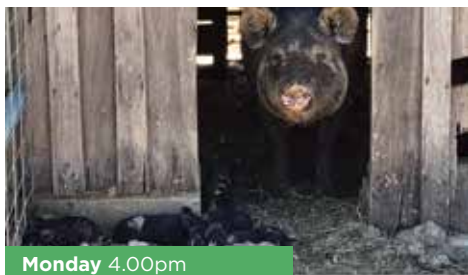

## THE GUNBOWER BUTTER FACTORY

Be Welcomed at The Gunbower Butter Factory's first open day since the start of it's restoration in 2017.

The Gunbower Butter Factory built in 1928 once employed many locals, supplying butter across Victoria and electricity to the Township of Gunbower. The building in Gunbower's Main Street has had very few external changes since the golden years with the original boiler in the backyard and many pullies featured throughout the factory.

Closing it's doors as a very popular and much loved Butter Factory in 1959 the large building was transformed into a home and has changed hands many times since. In the last two years the restoration of the near derelict building has commenced. The Gunbower Butter Factory is now the proud home of Jon and Letitia and their three year old daughter Frankie.

A part of the building has been transformed into a bnb (The Wattle Room) a second section into the family home and the main factory upgraded and restored to one day host weddings, workshops and events.

## COHUNA & DISTRICT HISTORICAL SOCIETY MUSEUM

## MASONIC LODGE

Lodge number 227 was consecrated on September 9, 1913, a year after a group of 12 local men began efforts to seek approval for its formation.

At this time, Cohuna was a small village consisting of a Sawmill, Hotel, Dairy Factory and of course the Police Station. There was also a General Store but at this stage no Railway. There was however a feeling of confidence among members of the community who could envisage the potential of Irrigation and an increase in production of Dairying and Horticulture to supply the Melbourne markets.

The newly founded Lodge had been through a horrific war, survived a depression and extended the Lodge rooms.

On May the 14th 1930 the first meeting was held in the new Temple and the old Lodge room became the supper room.

Reconsecration of the lodge after 100 years and community dinner was held on Saturday 31st May 2014

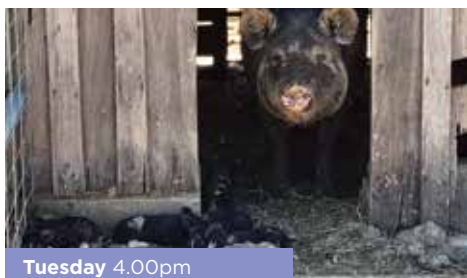
